6. Street Party;

This will be on the first Sunday of June, 5/6/16. Nick agreed to form a sub-committee nearer the time to organise this.

7. Street Clean,

This used to be the backbone of JAG but fewer and fewer people are volunteering to help. Since Urban Art depends on the hedges being cut this couldn't be left to chance so this year the Artists were charged a total of £1000 to pay for the hedges to be cut twice. In return for the use of the street for Urban Art, we get our hedges cut.

We will continue with the street clean though, as it involves more than the hedges and we will hope to combine it with a social event: Garden Party at no 1 Helix Gardens, 8/5/16

8.. Bike Sheds

Kathryn reported that following a meeting with some residents in Josephine and other roads in January, the streets had been petitioned in February and plans drawn up with the council for

bike sheds. It was noted that JAG had not been informed of any of this, which was unfortunate as it would have seemed an appropriate place to start such a campaign. Also that the Council had not sought to involve JAG in any way.
